Nudgee Road local upgrade works – April 2018

As part of the Gateway Upgrade North project, works to upgrade Nudgee Road between the Gateway Motorway northbound off-ramp and Childs Road at Nudgee are scheduled to commence from early May (see map overleaf).

The upgrade is being undertaken to provide additional capacity, ease congestion and improve safety and connectivity on the local road network and will involve:

- widening and resurfacing works between the Gateway Motorway northbound off-ramp and Childs Road
- installation of three new signalised intersections, including the Nudgee Road/Gateway Motorway northbound on-ramp and either side of the new Nudgee Road overpass
- inclusion of on-road cycle lanes and new footpath tie-ins to the existing off-road network.

Works include:

Site establishment works including fencing and barrier installation, and minor tree clearing, will commence along the western side of Nudgee Road from early May.

Traffic changes, including traffic control and reduced speed limits, will be implemented for driver safety for the duration of the works.

The following key works will be undertaken as part of the Nudgee Road upgrade:

- underground drainage work including the relocation of essential sewer services
- localised lane and road shoulder widening and resurfacing along sections of Nudgee Road
- modification of the Nudgee Road/Gateway Motorway northbound on-ramp intersection and the intersections either side of the new Nudgee Road overpass, to create new, signalised intersections
- upgrade of the pedestrian footpath on the western side of Nudgee Road, to tie in with the existing pedestrian and bicycle path at Nudgee Waterhole Reserve carpark
- installation of intelligent transport systems (ITS) infrastructure
- construction of concrete kerb, channel and centre median in some locations
- installation of road furniture, including lighting and guardrail to enhance public amenity and safety of the area

These works are expected to continue until late 2018, subject to weather and other construction conditions.

What to expect:

- increased noise, dust and vibration levels during some construction activities
- use of temporary lighting towers at night
- construction traffic accessing work areas, with vehicles fitted with flashing lights and reversing beepers for roadworker safety
- localised traffic changes on Nudgee Road including lane closures, temporary traffic stoppages, reduced speed limits and Police/traffic control
- minor pedestrian changes on Nudgee Road
- ongoing temporary closure of the Nudgee Waterhole Reserve carpark, with alternative parking available at the Banyo Rugby Leagues Club on Childs Road
- **permanent loss of some on-street parking on either side of Nudgee Road** (see information box below).

Working hours:

A combination of day and night work is required to complete the Nudgee Road upgrade.

The project's standard working hours are:

- **Day works:** Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 4pm.
- **Night works:** Monday to Friday, 7pm to 5am and Sunday, 4pm to 5am

All works are subject to weather and other construction conditions. We thank you for your ongoing patience and understanding during the project's works.

Nudgee Road on street parking changes

From early May, some on-street parking on Nudgee Road will be **permanently removed** (see map overleaf).

This will create space for necessary road widening and the establishment of on-road cycle lanes.

New parking opportunities will be available from mid-2018 within the new Nudgee heavy vehicle rest stop, currently under construction between the Gateway Motorway and Nudgee Service Centre.

The heavy vehicle rest stop will include:

- 25 parking bays, suitable for a range of heavy vehicles including trucks, caravans and buses
- outdoor table and chair facilities
- pedestrian walkways connecting to the existing Nudgee Service Centre car park.
