



# 2020 Men's Match Play Championship for the Steve King Trophy

## Conditions of Play

### Schedule of Event

Saturday 14 March ...Single Stroke – 8 lowest nett scores from the Bay Course and 8 lowest nett scores from the Gateway Course to qualify

Saturday 21 March ...Qtr Final Match Play Bay Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee – 7:28 & 7:36 and the Gateway Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee 7:44 & 7:52

Saturday 28 March ...Semi Final Match Play Bay Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee - 7:44 and the Gateway Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee at 7:52

Saturday 4 April ...Final Flight Match Play. Bay Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee 7:52 and the Gateway Flight from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee 7:52

Saturday 18 April ...Championship Final Match Play from 1<sup>st</sup> tee 7:52

- ◆ A \$5.00 entry fee (additional to the usual \$13.00 Competition Fee) is payable to the starter before commencing play in the Qualifying round on March 14.
- ◆ Players to register for the Match Play with the starter
- ◆ The leading 8 nett scores from the Bay Course will qualify for the Bay Flight and leading 8 nett scores from the Gateway Course will qualify for the Gateway Flight and compete in Match Play.
- ◆ In the event of ties in the qualifying round, the standard countback system will be used.
- ◆ 8 qualifiers will play each other in match play with the winner from each flight playing in the Championship Final to determine the 2020 Men's Champion.
- ◆ The draw for the Match Play will be seeded in nett qualifying order.
- ◆ Qualifying results and the Draw will be posted on the Nudgee Golf Club members website.

- ◆ In the event of a forfeit, the player claiming the forfeit is required to be at the 1<sup>st</sup> tee at the scheduled starting time, unless the forfeiting player advises the Club Office in writing, which will then be conveyed to the opponent.
- ◆ All Match Play will be played in groups of 4 on the Bay Golf Course, except for the Championship final which will be played as a two ball.
- ◆ Players are not required to play in the daily competition, it is an option.
- ◆ Match Play to be played under Match Play Rules using the Match Play indexes found on the back of the score card.
- ◆ Match Play must be played at the time stipulated by the draw.
- ◆ Handicaps used are the difference of  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the difference between stroke handicaps, as per handicap table. Players who's handicap reduces after qualifying must play on that handicap, if a players handicap increases, they must play off their qualifying handicap during the Match Play.
- ◆ Players are permitted to use motorised carts in the Championship provided motorised carts are permitted on the course at the day of play.
- ◆ The Match Committee will determine the conditions of play for each day and their decision is final.
- ◆ Players to record the match result at the score card reader computers
